

JACK QUIREY CORPS OF CADETS SCHOLARSHIP

The Jack Quirey Corps of Cadets Scholarship has been established to aid a Wharton County High School Graduate who will be attending Texas A&M University and is a member of the Corps of Cadets with \$1000 toward their college tuition.

High school seniors interested in receiving the scholarship must apply using the Wharton County A&M Club Scholarship Application Form. They are to attach a typewritten (double spaced) essay, not to exceed two pages, on "Why I want to be in the Corps of Cadets".

Students who are freshman, sophomores or juniors in the Corps may re-apply for this scholarship each year. They must submit a Jack Quirey Corps of Cadets Re-Apply Scholarship form to the Wharton County A&M Club along with a typewritten (double spaced) essay, not to exceed two pages, on "What the Corps of Cadets means to me".

Recipients of the scholarship will be announced at the Wharton County A&M Club Aggie Muster on April 21st, of each year. The student must contact the representative of the Wharton County A&M Club to provide their Texas A&M student identification number for the scholarship to be paid out in increments of \$500 per semester.
